

3500 – Campus Safety

The Board of Education is committed to a safe and secure work and learning environment. To that end, the Incident Command Team shall establish a campus safety plan and ensure that it is posted or otherwise made available to students and other members of the campus community.

3560 – Alcoholic Beverages

The President is authorized to enact procedures as appropriate and permitted by law regarding serving alcoholic beverages on campus or at a fundraising event held to benefit non-profit corporations. Alcoholic beverages shall not be served on campus except in accordance with these procedures.

3570 – Smoking and Other Tobacco Use and Possession on Campus

To enforce smoking and tobacco control regulations and procedures, the President is authorized to:

- Set enforcement standards for all Columbia Gorge Community College sites and campuses;
- Direct that the Columbia Gorge Community College post signs stating its tobacco use policy on campus, as follows:
 - the locations at which smoking or tobacco use is prohibited on campus;
 - the locations at which smoking or tobacco use is permitted on campus;
- Inform students, employees, and visitors of the tobacco use policy and enforcement measures.

Possession of tobacco products and inhalant delivery systems by persons under the age of 21 is prohibited on all Columbia Gorge Community College grounds and property. This includes, but is not limited to: in facility buildings, at facility-sponsored activities, in vehicles on facility grounds on all campuses, including satellite properties.

This policy applies to all Columbia Gorge Community College employees, volunteers, clients, students, visitors, vendors and contractors.

Exceptions to this policy are made for a person for whom a tobacco or nicotine product or a substance to be used with an inhalant delivery system has been lawfully prescribed.
