

Associate of Science Transfer—Computer Science | 90 Credits

The Associate of Science Transfer – Computer Science degree offers a streamlined path for CGCC students to gain credits and transfer seamlessly to an Oregon university in pursuit of a Bachelor of Science in Computer Science. This map is beneficial for students who know they want to transfer in Computer Science, but who may be unsure of their intended transfer destination. CGCC's program aligns with transfer requirements to Eastern Oregon University, Southern Oregon University and Western Oregon University. Students should work with their advisor to choose the best path for their goals, and to ensure they fulfill the requirements of this major transfer map.
