



## **2610 – Presentation of Initial Collective Bargaining Agreement**

The President is directed to enact administrative rules that assure compliance with any legal requirements regarding the presentation to the Board of Education of initial proposals for collective bargaining.

### **Legal Reference(s):**

1. There are no Oregon statutory requirements related to the Board of Education under the Public Employee Collective Bargaining Act (PECBA). The statute uses the broader term “community colleges” when defining public employer for purposes of PECBA. Boards of Education are permitted under Oregon Public meeting law to meet in executive session to deliberate with persons designated by the Board of Education to carry on labor negotiations (ORS 192.660(2)(d)).
