



2200 – Board of Education Duties and Responsibilities

- Represent the public interest;
- Establish policies that define the institutional mission and set prudent, ethical, and legal standards for college operations;
- Hire and evaluate the President;
- Delegate power and authority to the chief executive officer to effectively lead Columbia Gorge Community College
- Assure fiscal health and stability;
- Monitor institutional performance and educational quality; and
- Advocate and protect Columbia Gorge Community College
- Assure the Board operates in an open, accessible, welcoming spirit, and maintains an anti-racist culture.
