



2220– Board of Education Committees

The Board of Education may by action establish committees that it determines are necessary to assist the Board of Education in its responsibilities.

Board of Education committees are only advisory to the Board of Education and are not authorized to act on behalf of the Board unless the Board specifically delegates authority to act in the charge to the committee. Findings or recommendations of all Board Committees shall be reported to the Board of Education for consideration.

The Board of Education has established the following standing committees:

Standing Committees

Board Policy and Equity Committee: This standing committee reviews and recommends changes to Board of Education policies, and advances equity and inclusion initiatives.

Finance and Audit: This standing committee meets to review monthly Financial Statements, reviews the audit prior to full Board review, and is charged with bond oversight to ensure College bond projects fulfill objectives of bond elections.

President's Performance Review: This committee is charged with coordinating and leading the process for Board's annual performance review of the President. The Chair or Vice-Chair of the Board serve as Chair of this standing committee.
