The Board of Education is committed to assessing its own performance, as a Board of Education, in order to identify its strengths and areas in which it may improve its functioning.

The process for evaluation shall be recommended to and approved by the Board of Education.

The review of the Board goals and survey will take place in January of each year.

All Board of Education members will be asked to complete an evaluation instrument at the beginning of April and submit the evaluation to their Assistant by no later than May 1st. The Assistant will compile the results.

A summary of the evaluations will be presented and discussed at a Board of Education session scheduled in July. The results will be used to identify accomplishments in the past year and goals for the following year.
