



Provide **one** of the following documents that indicate your high school completion status prior to when you will begin college in 2018–2019:

- A copy of your high school diploma or modified diploma. Extended diplomas are not eligible.
- A copy of your final official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.
- A copy of your General Educational Development (GED) certificate or GED transcript.
- If you completed secondary education in a foreign country, a copy of the “secondary school leaving certificate” or other similar document.
- An academic transcript that indicates you successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor’s degree.
- If state law does not require a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), such as in Oregon, a homeschool transcript or the equivalent, signed by your parent or guardian, which lists the secondary school courses you completed and documents the successful completion of a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.
- A secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), if required by state law for a homeschool student (*not applicable in Oregon*).

Your aid eligibility may be grandfathered in if, prior to July 1, 2014, you had an academic transcript showing prior enrollment and one of the following:

- Placement exam scores that met ability-to-benefit minimums, or
- You completed at least six credits that apply toward an aid-eligible certification or degree program (if not from CGCC, must be certified by your prior college).
