During Probation, you may be required to fulfill specific terms and conditions such meeting with your Academic Advisor to revise your Ed Plan, taking a reduced course load or enrolling in specific courses. Also, you must be able to complete your program within the 150% Maximum Credit Limit with at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.

Note for Students on a Credit Extension Appeal (CEA): You must resubmit your CEA once your SAP Appeal is approved.

Note for Loan Borrowers: You must submit a Federal Direct Loan Revision request to reinstate previously canceled loans.
