

Request to Decline Federal Pell Grant Funds

Disclosure: Per the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2012 (Public Law 112-74), lifetime eligibility for a Federal Pell Grant is limited to six full-time-equivalent years (18 quarters/12 semesters), or 600% of an annual Federal Pell Grant award, toward an undergraduate degree. Usage is calculated from 1973 as reported in the Common Origination and Disbursement system.

To manage your usage, you may decline part or all of your Pell award. You may want to do this if you expect your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) to decrease in the future, or if you'd like to save possible funding toward a more expensive college/program.

Before you decline funding, you need to understand the following:

- 1) This action is completely voluntary and not necessarily recommended, as future availability of the program is NOT guaranteed.
- 2) It may represent a partial or full return of your disbursement(s) for the current and/or future terms.
- 3) It will be denied if any applicable repayment cannot be processed.
- 4) It may apply only to your current academic year.
- 5) The deadline to submit this request is the current term's final Installment Loan due date.
- 6) Once CGCC returns declined funds to the Federal Pell Grant program, any request to recover the funds may not be possible (ex. after the close of the academic year).
