 - d. Were engaged in active duty in the US Armed Forces but released under dishonorable conditions.

- Go to www.fafsa.gov to update your FAFSA, answering **NO** for active duty or veteran
- Include parental information, if applicable, on your FAFSA application, if you have not already done so
