Outcome #1 Method to assess student understanding *

Students will choose a topic, research and create a short speech or presentation on their topic. The other students will have a feedback form with a rating scale of 1–5 where they assess how well they communicated the information in their chosen topic speech.

Outcome #2 Method to assess student understanding *

Using the same assignment of the short speech or presentation, the speaker will give the other students a short quiz based on the speech. All students will be evaluated on their listening competency.

Outcome #3 Method to assess student understanding *

Students will be required to write a short essay, after which I will evaluate their writing using a writing rubric.
