Outcome #1 Method to assess student understanding *

Students will actively participate in a variety of individual and collaborative reading and writing assignments that require critical thinking and problem-solving. They will also discuss about and reflect on Japanese videos and film used in class.

Outcome #2 Method to assess student understanding *

Students will participate in various small-group activities to acquire and/or exchange target information. They will also create skits or dialogues for common situations by using more informal Japanese.

Outcome #3 Method to assess student understanding *

Students will actively participate in class through interacting with peers and the instructor in an immersion-style learning environment. They will present oral presentations, pass one-to-

one oral interviews with the instructor, and present collaborative mini-presentations in class.

4. How will you know if you were successful in your efforts to teach this outcome?

Students will be able to explain and express their opinions in well-organized writing 80% of the time. They will be able to agree or disagree about topics by using a variety of sentence structures orally or in writing. Their writings will be graded against a rubric; they will score above 80%.

How will you know if you were successful in your efforts to teach this outcome?

75% of students will be able to correctly use intermediate and advanced-level structures, such as a combination of simple and complex sentences, to acquire or exchange target information. They will be able to use both formal and informal speeches.

Outcome #2 *

How will you know if you were successful in your efforts to teach this outcome?

85% of students will be able to successfully converse with the instructor and score above 85 % on oral interviews. They will be able to score above 85% on oral presentation(s).
