Do not include students who withdrew or earned an incomplete) *	Quizzes: 132 is the average score for the quizzes administered throughout the term. This is a solid "B" average for the learners. Tests: The average score for tests was 137.9. This is an "A" average for the learners. Papers: The average for the three required papers is 18.15. A "C" average of the three papers is 22.6. The combined scores for the learners, for the papers, is less than a "C" average. I believe this is due to missing assignments from several learners, lowering the overall average of the class.
Outcome #1 *	A "C" average or higher was achieved by 21 out of 26 learners in this course for Winter Term. The remaining learners received a "D" or an "F".
