NCLEX type exam for NUR110- the nat. norm is 66%, the student cohort is 61.4%. this exam revealed that the students were not at the national level, but improved from the previous cohort year. So Kaplan scores are improving. No changes are planned at this time. Exam scores for the next two terms revealed an improvement to be above the national norm. NUR111-Nat. norm is 49%, student cohort is 57.5%. NUR112-Nat. norm is 65%, student cohort is 73.9%. All students participated in and passed the Cases Study Capstone presentation above the 70% target level. All students passed the clinical PBO for NUR110, 1 student did not pass the clinical PBO for NUR111, all students passed the clinical PBO for NUR 112.
