

Immunization Requirements for CGCC Nursing/ Medical Assistant/ EMS/ CNA2

- **Tdap** (tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis) Adults dose no older than past 10 years [but must not expire while in Program]; Td within past 10 years ok as long as has had an adult dose of Tdap at some point; Dtap are children's doses and are not acceptable)
- **MMR** (measles [rubeola], mumps, rubella; 2 documented doses at least 28 days apart or immunity by titer, i.e., positive titers for each one: rubeola, mumps, and rubella)*
- **Varicella** (aka VZV; 2 documented doses at least 28 days apart or immunity by titer, i.e., positive titer)*
- **Hep B** (3 documented doses to be completed by stated deadline; for Nursing Program this is the end of fall term of NUR 110; typical injection schedule is 0, 1, & 6 mo; or positive [good, adequate] titer)
- **Influenza** (Seasonal. Required only if attending hospital/ clinic -based clinical in fall term unless otherwise stated. Students may request to sign a declination statement.)

*If 2 doses of both MMR & Varicella are needed, the MMR & Varicella injections must be done at the same time; otherwise, a moderate wait time is needed between the 2 series.

Depending on which program you are entering there may be other requirements. Those listed above are just the immunizations.
