1. Please provide any high-level documentation of the existing building, such as site plan, overall floor plans and structural plans.

Response: At present, efforts to collect as-built or as-designed information have been unsuccessful.

2. Is it possible to indicate how many firms have expressed interest, or that have been sent the directions to the RFP?

Response: The RFP process does not have a mechanism for tracking interested firms. Notice of the RFP was published publicly in the Portland Daily Journal and Columbia Gorge News. To date 6 firms have made contact regarding the RFP. RFP documents are available on the Columbia Gorge Community College web site.

3. Although there is no pre-proposal meeting, is it possible to gain access to and look at the interior of the existing building?

Is it possible to have a site walk visit during the first week of January 2024?

On page 11 it notes site visits may be provided. Is it possible to request a site visit?

Response: We are not planning on a building tour for RFP responders. A tour, <u>IF</u> conducted will be reserved for short listed firms prior to an interview. It will be a short notice of availability.

4. Can it be disclosed, who is doing the existing building systems assessment referred to in the RFP?

Response: Stantec Consulting Services Inc.

5. Please share a bit about the anticipated pedagogical approach or comparable early learning programs. For example, are there specific aspirations for this facility which would exceed state requirements for Early Learning and Child -Care?

Response: Yes, aspiration is that the reimagined facility will exceed basic requirements in all respects. Childrens learning, resiliency, environmental sensitivity, and energy usage. A goal of this first phase is to quantify those goals and balance them with what is anticipated as possible for fundraising.

6. Are there any aspirations for educational space or multi-purpose space to serve CGCC students who will be participating in practicum at this Early Learning Center?

Response: Yes, CGCC ECE program will have a footprint in the new facility. What that is and how it manifests in the physical building is to be determined.
