- ☐ **Meet with an Academic Advisor** – [Make an appointment with an Advisor](#) to discuss your class placement, review transcripts, and/or set up a plan for the new term.
- ☐ **Apply for Financial Aid (optional)** – Complete either the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov or the Oregon Student Aid Application (ORSAA) at oregonstudentaid.gov.

- ☐ **Explore MyCGCC** – The Student Portal, [MyCGCC](#), is the platform you will use to access your student email, register for courses, check grades, check financial aid, set up your Global Financial account, access Moodle, and more.

- ☐ **Register for Classes** – Log into your [MyCGCC student portal](#) and enroll in classes.
- ☐ **Attend the New Student Orientation (NSO)** – Dates TBD
- ☐ **Technology Access** – Online and virtual classes will require you to use the platforms Moodle and Zoom. **Access your class in Moodle within the first 3 days of the term, otherwise you run the risk of being dropped from the class.**
