New Business:	Lorie explains that local community partners have requested an EMT/Paramedic program to be offered at the college to fill in the need in our community and surrounding areas. Lorie explains that there are such programs located on the west and east side of the state.	

	<p>But graduated students tend to get hired in those areas and central rural Oregon is in need of people in this field. The CGCC's program will be unique as it will focus on the needs of rural areas not municipal areas.</p> <p>Susan asked what's the difference between this EMT program and the past EMT program that had low-enrollment and was eventually suspended. Lorie explains from her knowledge that with this new EMT program there is local involvement from fire and rescue agencies for participation and recruitment to the program, this could have been lacking from the previous program.</p>

<p>EMS 231: Paramedic Clinical 1 (New CTE Course)</p>	<p>Susan asked about the audit for this course, Lorie explains that if a paramedic needs a refresher on their skills an audit would be a good option.</p> <p>Mary asked because audits don't have grades, how will the student or their supervisor/captain know how the student did. Lorie said that the student will have in field feedback from their mentor, but she will think of how to relay that information in an evaluation that can be shared, similar to a grade.</p> <p>Susan noted that the degree has a cultural competency outcome; however, there are no courses that have cultural competency as an outcome.
