- 4. Departmental faculty involvement. This was a team effort, with another part time EMT faculty teaching on the days the primary faculty was not available. The students had positive comments about booth instructors.

They must pass exam this to be eligible to apply for licensure in Oregon as an EMT. our students did very well.

For the past several years this course has been offered 40 % online, the instructors, considering the course content and the changes in the State and National testing, placing more emphasis on hands-on demonstration of skills related to cases scenarios, they have decided to increase the course to 100% face-to-face. There will be more integration of technical skills and active student participation throughout the class time.
